GREEN CARTS ARE ROLLING YOUR WAY!

The City of Saskatoon is moving to a city-wide green cart program in the spring of 2023 and ending the green cart subscription program. Every household with rollout black and blue carts will be part of the program.

What to expect

- Green carts and kitchen pails are being delivered throughout March and April. Subscribers to the previous green cart program will get a kitchen pail delivered but will continue to use their existing carts.
- Year-round biweekly collection begins in May. Fees will not be applied on utility bills until May.
- Black cart collection will continue as biweekly, even in the summer months. More than half of what we throw away can go into the green cart! That's why black carts won't need to be collected as often.

Using the green carts will help divert up to 20,000 tonnes, the same as 3,300 garbage truck loads, from the City landfill each year, delaying the need for a new landfill and increasing Saskatoon's waste diversion by up to 12%.

CARBON MONOXIDE ALARMS SAVE LIVES

Carbon monoxide (CO) is an odourless, colourless, tasteless, deadly gas. Elevated levels of carbon monoxide can cause illness or death before people even know it is there.

A carbon monoxide alarm will alert you if dangerous levels of carbon monoxide are accumulating. Carbon monoxide alarms should be installed outside each sleeping area and are most effective when interconnected throughout your home.

If your carbon monoxide alarm sounds or you suspect carbon monoxide in your home, immediately move to a location with fresh air and call 9-1-1.
