# Recycling

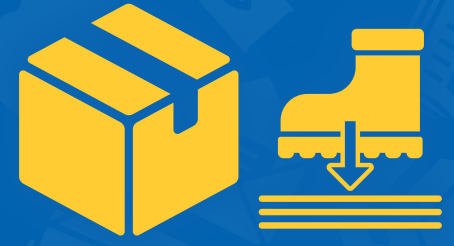


## Aluminum Foil and Tin Cans



## Beverage Containers

Milk and Drink Cartons  
Remove all caps. Empty, rinse, and flatten all containers.



## Flattened Cardboard



## Household Glass

Remove all caps.

Household glass can be taken to SARCAN or placed in your Blue Cart or Bin.



## Mixed Paper

Place shredded paper in a clear, tied plastic bag.



## Plastic Containers



## Do not bag or box items; loosely place into your Blue Cart or Bin.

Items should be 5 cm x 8 cm (2" x 3") to be placed into recycling. Saskatoon residents can use the City's free recycling depots to drop off the same clean, unsorted materials accepted in the Blue Cart and Blue Bin residential recycling programs.
