7. REPORTS FROM ADMINISTRATION

7.1 Naming Advisory Committee Report (Files CK. 6310-1 and PL. 4001-5-2)

Ms. Dale Dodman spoke to the Committee regarding the Zimmer and Dolan submissions. John Dolan and Wayne Zimmer were both advocates for the mentally and physically handicapped community in Saskatoon. Both men were involved in the development of the first school for the mentally and physically handicapped. Dolan and Zimmer were men with deep roots in the City, as well as, the province.

Ms. Ellen Pearson, City Planner, City of Saskatoon spoke to the Anne Szumigalski submission. Ms. Pearson suggested that the existing 'Industrial Park' be renamed the 'Anne Szumigalski Park'. Ms. Anne Szumigalski was born in 1922 in London, England, immigrated to Canada in 1951, and then settled in Saskatoon in 1956. She was a famous poet, founder of the Saskatchewan Writer's Guild, and taught poetry for more than a decade. Ms. Szumigalski was also named woman of the year in 1988 by the Saskatchewan YWCA, and was nominated three times for the Governor General's Award.

Mr. Terry Fusco, City Planner, City of Saskatoon presented the report of the North Sector Plan. Six names were put forward to the Committee for consideration of the renaming of the Northwest Industrial area.

The renaming of 'Victor Road' in Stonebridge was discussed and 'Vic Boulevard' was the suggested name change.

The name 'Skopik' was submitted to the Committee for a street, park, or municipal name request.

The speakers were excused prior to further discussion and consideration of the applications.

That the names 'Dolan' and 'Zimmer' be submitted to the Standing Policy Committee on Planning, Development and Community Services recommending that the names be added to the Names Master List.
