

Fats, oils and grease (FOG) that go down the drain can create unpleasant odours, clog pipes, and can lead to costly sewer back-ups in your business and in the community.

# **COMMON SOURCES OF FOG:**

# Fats:

Butter, shortening, lard Creamy sauces Soups

### Oils:

Olive oil and cooking oils
Salad dressings, etc.

# **Grease:**

Bacon grease Gravy, drippings from roasted meats, etc.



# Clear the FOG by following these simple steps:







Scrape FOG off dishes and cooking equipment.

Wipe dishes and cooking equipment before washing.

Ensure the sink strainer is in place before washing dishes or pouring anything down the sink.
