

# How to Check the Voters List & Register Online to Vote in Saskatoon's 2024 Municipal and School Board Election



This guide provides a step-by-step approach for eligible voters who wish to check their name on the Voters List or Register to Vote in Saskatoon's 2024 Municipal and School Board election.

1 Navigate to [saskatoon.ca/voterlookup](https://saskatoon.ca/voterlookup)

2 Click "Register to Vote".

## Voters List Lookup and Registration

**Elections Saskatoon** will use a registered Voters List for the **2024 Civic Election**. Register and/or update your information ahead of time will help reduce wait-times at the polls and make your voting experience faster.

With the online registration portal, you can check, update or add your information to the Voters List.

**Follow these easy steps:**

- Open the **Elections Saskatoon Voters List Portal** (**Register to Vote** box above)
- Enter the required information (type your address slowly, and select your complete address from the list)
- Lookup your information, review to make sure it is correct
- Add your preferred contact information **and** update the school division you support.
- If you are a resident of Saskatoon, you will select either the public school or separate school (if you are of the Catholic Faith and wish to vote for the separate school division trustee).
- Only voters who own assessable property, but do not reside in Saskatoon will select "No School support"

*Note: If your address is a multi-unit property, only enter the property address, and select your unit or apartment*

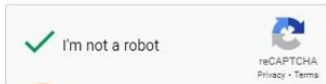

### Voter Eligibility

This is Elections Saskatoon's Online Voter Registration. To vote in the 2024 Civic Election, you must meet the following criteria as of November 13, 2024:

- You are a Canadian citizen and at least 18 years of age on the day of the election;
- You have resided in Saskatchewan for at least six consecutive months;
- You are a resident of Saskatoon, or you have owned assessable land within the City of Saskatoon for at least three consecutive months.

#### Definitions Related to Assessable Land

- (a) Use your highest assessed land if you own more than one property within the municipality; and
- (b) If you don't reside in Saskatoon, but own land, the assessed land must be registered in the voter's name, not registered in a company name;
- (c) select No School Support in the school Support field.
