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




Eligible voters, you can apply for your mail-in ballot through a **few options:**

- 1. Online through the Mail-in Ballot Application Portal
- 2. Complete your mail-in ballot $\underline{application\ form}$ and return via $\underline{email}\ to\underline{elections@saskatoon.ca}$


Filling Out the Form

Next, review the voter eligibility criteria and enter your personal information, 6 including name as it appears on your I.D. and date of birth. **Elections** Mail-in Ballot Request You must be an eligible voter to request a mail-in ballot for voting in the 2024 Civic Election Voter Eligibility criteria as of November 13, 2024: · You are a Canadian citizen and at least 18 years of age on the day of the election; · You have resided in Saskatchewan for at least six consecutive months; · You are a resident of Saskatoon, or you have owned assessable land within the City of Saskatoon for at least three consecutive months. 
7 Click the "School Support" drop-down and select your school division. Residents of Saskatoon must select either Public School or Separate School.
To vote in the Separate school division, you must be of the Catholic faith (any

Catholic rite, such as Roman, Ukrainian, Chaldean, etc., that recognizes the pope as the leader of the church.)

Only voters who own assessable property, but do NOT reside in Saskatoon, will select "No School Support".




8 Enter your preferred contact information. Please note only email addresses will receive communications tracking the status of applications and kit.


Provide your mail-in ballot kit mailing address; this address is where your mail-in ballot kit will be sent.



11 Attach your I.D. document(s):

Option 1. Driver's Licence or Saskatchewan Identification Card. It has your name and address and is all you need.

Option 2. Two pieces of I.D. Both must show your name and at least one shows your current address. There are 50+ options (see list here).




Note! If you use a cell-phone to fill out the mail-in ballot application, use the camera to take a picture of your I.D. for convenience.


