

• Local Roadway Reconfiguration: The local roadway network within the amendment area is reconfigured:

Saskatoon City Council will consider an amendment to the Brighton Neighbourhood Concept Plan proposed by

- Local Roadway Reconfiguration: The local roadway network within the amendment area is reconfigured; notably by moving the western-most roadway to the east allowing for residential lots on each side.
- Changes to Land Use: The dominant land use within the amendment area is to remain as Single Unit/Semi Unit Detached Dwellings. However, as a result of a reduction of roadway area, an additional 0.05 ha (0.124 ac)
- Adjustment to Municipal Reserve: To accommodate the items listed above, the layout of the proposed Municipal Reserve (MR) area is also reconfigured. No change in the area of MR is to occur from the amendment.
 Updated Figures and Statistics: Updated Figures and statistics throughout to align with the map amendments outlined.



REASON FOR THE AMENDMENT – The proposed amendments to the Brighton Neighbourhood Concept Plan increase the amount of developable frontage, reduce municipal roadway areas, and improve marketability of BDM's next phase of development.
