

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

- WHAT:** Relocation of Lakewood Community Garden
WHEN: Throughout November and December 2024
WHERE: Lakewood Civic Centre site (Heritage Crescent)

Throughout November and December 2024, construction activities will be occurring to relocate and establish the Lakewood community garden to a new location at the Lakewood Civic Centre. This work is expected to take approximately **4 - 8 weeks** and will include:

- Removal of four (4) poplar trees
- Lifting and relocating 'the Bond' statue on site
- Stripping, rototilling and prepping the soil for a new community garden
- Relocating moveable items from the current location to the new community garden location
- Relocating the Lakewood Civic Centre sign to a new location

What to Expect During Construction

- We anticipate only minimal disruptions to the Lakewood Civic Centre and parking lot during this phase.
- Some heavy equipment will be required to complete this work.
- Some noise and vibration are anticipated.
- Stay clear of the work zone for your safety and the safety of workers.
- Access to the Lakewood Civic Centre will be maintained throughout the project.

Common Questions



Where is the community garden being relocated?

The community garden, currently located at the southwest corner near McKercher Drive and Heritage Crescent, will be moved further east along Heritage Crescent. The relocation of the community garden is being done in preparation for use in the new location for the growing season in 2025.



Will parking be affected?

The gravel parking lot at the southwest corner of the site will be removed. Future construction work will include new parking spaces being added to the Lakewood Civic Centre Site.

There is no planned disruption to parking throughout the month of November while this work is performed.



Will I still be able to access the Civic Centre, Tennis Dome and Library?

There is no impact to the operations of the Lakewood Civic Centre, Cliff Wright Library or the Lakewood Indoor Tennis Center.
